SAMPLE PROGRAMME: October 2009

What's included

- 12 German lessons over 4 afternoons (each lesson is 45 minutes)
- Two closed tuition, all class materials included
- Seven nights accommodation in selected homestays, shared rooms, half board
- One full day trip (Sunday), one half day trip (Saturday) and three morning activities/ cultural visits e.g. museums/ local places of interest
- All trips and activities guided by a member of Munich school staff, with entrances and transport costs included
- Transfers from Berlin airport on arrival and departure
- Full support from local course co-ordinator throughout trip
- Free place for 1 group leader with a group of 10-14 students or 2 group leaders for 15-20 students (homestay, single room, half board)
- Local transport (weekly ticket)
