

## Teen German, Radolfzell 2010



The summer school is a great holiday for teenagers aged 15–17 years who want to combine learning German with a wide range of sporting and cultural activities, go on interesting excursions or simply have fun. The Summer School provides an authentically German environment in the beautiful setting of Lake Constance (Bodensee). Lake Constance is the largest lake in Germany and also borders Austria and Switzerland making it the ideal location for excursions and discovery of the three German speaking countries.

**Tuition:** 24 German lessons per week (each lesson = 45 minutes).

**Accommodation:** This can be in with a local homestay or at the school residence:

**Homestay:** for those looking for total immersion in German culture, a host family is ideal. Students will live in a comfortable home and often share in the everyday life of their hosts, sometimes even in their family activities. They will have a single furnished room with access to the appropriate facilities and meals will be provided either by the host family or in local restaurants. Most families can be reached on foot from the school or quite easily by bus.

**School residence:** the residential campus is located 20 minute on foot from the school (10 minutes by bus). Students are accommodated in single or double rooms and have the use of shared bathroom and kitchen facilities on each floor/ corridor. There is also a communal area with TV. All meals are taken in a large range of local restaurants and cafes using vouchers provided by the school.

### Excursions and activities

An attractive leisure activity programme ensures the German tuition is accompanied by fun, sport and entertainment. Activities are organised on 3 days each week in addition to a full day each Saturday; Students have free time on Sundays. Extra sporting activities such as tennis, horse riding, sailing etc can be organised on request for an additional fee.

### Dates and prices

This programme runs from **Monday 7 June - Friday 27 August** (arrivals on Sunday/ departures on Saturday). Minimum duration is 2 weeks (last possible start date is Monday 16 August). Beginners must start on set dates (please contact us for details).

Fees include tuition, activity programme, full board accommodation on course days and half board on weekends.
